STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment would allow the creation of a watershed district covering the towns of Hope, Lincolnville and Camden which would include the Camden and Rockland Water Company and the Megunticook Watershed Association. The amendment also adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause.
