Elderly Community Services.**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the
5 General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

15 Provides funds to demonstrate primary
17 prevention with approximately 210 youth
19 enabling approximately 325 elderly people to
21 live more independently and securely. Of
23 the 210 youth, 50% will be youth at large,
25 30% will be youth at risk and 20% will be
youth referred by the Department of
Corrections. This appropriation for a
community services project will provide no
more than 75% of expenditures to operate one
program in Rockland, one in Portland and 2
programs in other areas of the State.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

31 This bill provides funds to demonstrate primary prevention
33 with approximately 210 youth enabling approximately 325 elderly
35 people to live more independently and securely. Of the 210
37 youth, 50% will be youth at large, 30% will be youth at risk and
39 20% will be youth referred by the Department of Corrections.
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
