SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1215, L.D. 1687, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Lobster and Crab Fishing License Law"

Amend the amendment in the 5th paragraph after the title in the last line (page 1, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the following: "one or more unlicensed crew members" and inserting in its place the following: 'a maximum of 2 unlicensed crew members'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that a Class II lobster and crab fishing license holder may engage a maximum of 2 unlicensed crew members.
