33	revenue to the General Fund and the Lobster Fund. However, exact reduction cannot be determined at this time but is expected to be

37	court filings in our State's court system. The Judicial Department has indicated that it could absorb these costs
	utilizing existing resources.'

4.3	STATEMENT OF FACT
43	This amendment provides only 2 classes of licenses and
45	requires the Class II license holder to be responsible for any
47	unlicensed individuals in the license holder's crew. The
47	amendment also adds a fiscal note.
