HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1217, L.D. 1689, Bill, "An Act Relating to Periodic Justification of Departments and Agencies of State Government under the Maine Sunset Laws"

Amend the amendment in the 19th indented paragraph from the end in the 2nd line (page 7, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "§3492." and inserting in its place the following: "§3402."

Further amend the amendment in the 17th indented paragraph from the end by striking out all of the last 2 underlined sentences (page 8, lines 4 to 11 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following: 'Any person ordered by the board to correct a plumbing deficiency or to vacate a building or structure may appeal the order to the Superior Court pursuant to the Maine Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 80B, by filing a petition for review within 48 hours of receipt of the order. The order by the Plumbers' Examining Board shall not be stayed unless by order of the Superior Court for good cause.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 16th indented paragraph from the end (page 8, lines 13 to 17 in amendment)

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment substitutes the review procedure for orders by the Plumbers' Examining Board in committee amendment "A" for those commonly used under the Maine Rules of Civil Procedure.
