An Act Relating to Hunting and Fishing Licenses.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	12 MRSA §7151, sub-§3, ¶C, as amended by PL 1985, c. 575, §§1 and 4, is further amended to read:

7	C. Any resident who procures a one-day or 3-day <u>fishing</u> license may exchange it for an annual resident fishing license <u>or a resident combination hunting and fishing</u>
9	<u>license</u> in the town in which he <u>that person</u> resides upon the payment of \$1 to the clerk or issuing agent and -in-the-case
11	of-the-one-day-license, the difference between the fee for that the one-day or 3-day license and the fee for the annual
13	license.

17	STATEMENT OF FACT
19	This bill clarifies that residents may exchange a one-day of 3-day fishing license for either an annual fishing license or a
21	combination hunting and fishing license. This exchange provision currently applies only to annual resident fishing licenses.
