## STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment corrects references from the Presque Isle Band of Micmac Indians to the Aroostook Band of Micmac Indians, 6 and changes the appointment procedure of the tribal representatives. It also adds an emergency preamble and an 8 emergency clause.

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This amendment deletes the reference to a report in section
5 and clarifies that the commission is responsible for its own
staff support. The amendment states that members are not eligible for reimbursement of expenses. The amendment also adds
a fiscal note.
