## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B " to S.P. 607, L.D. 1701

This amendment adds the Micmac Indians to the membership of the Commission to Study the Establishment of a State and Tribal Partnership to Encourage Economic Development and requires that all members of the commission serve without compensation. The commission has the option to submit any report or legislation it prepares to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council and to the Legislature by January 31, 1991. This amendment also removes the need for the appropriation contained in the original bill.
