IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Amend the Charter of the Canton Water District.

(After Deadline)

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1957, c. 44, §1 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Sec. 1. Territorial limits; name; purposes. The inhabitants and7territory of the Town of Canton in the County of Oxford shall
constitute a body politic and corporate under the name of "Canton9Water District" for the purpose of supplying the town and the
inhabitants and others of the district with pure water for11domestic, sanitary, commercial and municipal purposes.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1957, c. 44, §6, next to the last paragraph, last sentence, is amended to read:

The trustees, as such, shall receive as compensation for their services an amount to be determined by them not to exceed \$100 \$500 each per year and the compensation of the chair of the board of trustees shall not exceed \$800 per year; but the treasurer may be allowed such compensation as the trustees shall 21 determine.

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Sec. 3. P&SL 1957, c. 44, §10, first sentence, is amended to read:

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25 For accomplishing the purposes of this act, and for such other expenses as may be necessary for the carrying out of said 27 purposes, said district, through its trustees, without district vote, is authorized to borrow money temporarily and to issue 29 therefore its negotiable notes, and for the purpose of renewing and refunding the indebtedness so created, of paying any necessary expenses and liabilities incurred under the provisions 31 of including organizational and other necessary this act, expenses and liabilities whether incurred by the district or the 33 town of Canton, the district being authorized to reimburse said town of Canton for any such expenses incurred by it, and in 35 acquiring properties, paying damages, laying pipes, mains, aqueducts and conduits, constructing, maintaining and operating a 37 water plant or system and making renewals, additions, extensions 39 and improvements to the same; and to cover interest payments during the period of construction, said district, through its 41 trustees, without district vote, is also authorized to issue, to time, bonds, from time notes or other evidences of indebtedness of the district in one series, or in separate 43 series, in such amount or amounts, bearing interest at such rate 45 or rates, and having such terms and provisions as the trustees shall determine; provided, however, that the total indebtedness 47 of said district at any one time outstanding shall not exceed the sum of \$200,000 <u>\$1,000,000</u>.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the charter of the Canton Water District by increasing the territorial limits to include the entire Town of Canton; increasing trustee compensation; and increasing the borrowing limit for the water district.

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
