24	2-A. Master plumber license. The board may issue a master plumber license to a person who submits an application therefor
26	on a form prescribed by the board and who provides satisfactory evidence of the following qualifications:
. 28	A. A minimum of at least one year with 2,000 hours of work in the field of plumbing installations as a journeyman
30	plumber of a minimum of at least 4 years with 8,000 hours of work - in the -field of - plumbing - installations - as - a - trainee
32	plumber under the <u>employment and general</u> supervision of a master plumber,-ef-the-equivalent; and

36	B. Obtaining a passing grade, as determined by the board on the master's examination.

HOUSE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{H} " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 615, L.D. 1710

STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment changes Committee Amendment "A" to require general supervision rather than direct supervision by a master 6 plumber as one of the qualifications for a master plumber license. The amendment also provides that a graduate of a Maine 8 technical college, having successfully completed a course of study in plumbing, is qualified as a master plumber. 10
