HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 632,
L.D. 1725, Bill, "An Act to Amend Maine's Underground Oil Storage
Law"

Amend the amendment in section 15 by inserting after the
amending clause the following:

'\$568-A. Fund coverage requirements'

Further amend the amendment in section 15 in subsection 1 in
paragraph B in subparagraph (4) in division (b) in the last line
(page 21, line 16 in amendment) by inserting after the
following: "equipment" the following: ', and any rules adopted
pursuant to that subsection'

Further amend the amendment in section 15 in subsection 1 in
paragraph B in subparagraph (4) in division (c) in the last line
(page 21, line 19 in amendment) by inserting after the
following: "paragraph F" the following: ', and any rules
adopted pursuant to that subsection'

Further amend the amendment in section 15 in subsection 1 in
paragraph D by inserting at the end the following: 'This limit
includes claims made in subsequent years on those discharges.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows for a phase-in of technical
requirements on existing facilities and clarifies the conditions
of a limit on the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund.
