SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 632, L.D. 1725, Bill, "An Act to Amend Maine's Underground Oil Storage Law"


Amend the amendment in section 15 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph E.

Further amend the amendment in section 15 in subsection 2 in the schedule by striking out the last 2 lines (page 22, lines 45 and 46 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

<u>'11 to 30</u>	<u>25,000</u>
<u>over 30</u>	<u>50,000'</u>

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment deletes the section of the committee amendment that excludes refineries and businesses that have a relationship with a refiner from participating in the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund. The amendment also provides for a more gradual schedule of deductibles.
