SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 632, L.D. 1725, Bill, "An Act to Amend Maine's Underground Oil Storage Law"

Amend the amendment in section 15 in subsection 1 in paragraph E in the last blocked paragraph in the next to the last line (page 22, line 30 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "oil" the following: 'or related services'

Further amend the amendment in section 15 in subsection 1 in paragraph E in the last blocked paragraph in the last line (page 22, line 31 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "consumption" the following: 'or if the tank or facility that is the subject of the application is leased by an oil refinery, prior to the effective date of this Act, to an entity which is not owned directly or indirectly by an oil refinery'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the exclusion from eligibility for the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund does not apply to tanks which are leased to entities that are not owned directly or indirectly by an oil refinery.
