13	HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 635, L.D. 1726, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Banking Code"

17	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
19	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
21	as emergencies; and
23	Whereas, the Treasurer of State, Abandoned Property Division, is in the process of completing its audit of banks and
25	other financial institutions; and
27	Whereas, the banks and other financial institutions are concerned with observing the statutory provisions against
29	disclosure of confidential information to unauthorized persons; and
31	Whereas, the authority of the Abandoned Property Division
33	for access to confidential records necessary for audit purposes is not totally clear; and
35	Whereas, it is in the public interest for those audits to be
37	completed as expeditiously as possible; and
39	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
41	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
43	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
45	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in
47	its place the following:

A, §14, is amended to read: 3 Any disclosure of records made pursuant to Title 22, Ι. 5 section 16; or Sec. 2. 9-B MRSA §151, sub-§2, ¶J, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 7 311, $\S4$, is amended to read: 9 J. Any disclosure of records made under the Federal Currency and Foreign Transactions Reporting Act, Public Law 11 91-508, 31 United States Code, section 5311, et seq., as amended - ; or 13 Sec. 3. 9-B MRSA §161, sub-§2, ¶K is enacted to read: 15 17 K. The examination or furnishing of any financial records by a fiduciary institution to any officer, employee or agent 19 of the Treasurer of State for use solely in the exercise of that officer's, employee's or agent's duties under the 21 Unclaimed Property Act, Title 33, chapter 37. Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 23 preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.' 25 27 STATEMENT OF FACT 29 This amendment makes it clear that disclosure of financial 31 records to the Treasurer of State in the performance of the Treasurer of State's duties under the Unclaimed Property Act, the 33 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 33, chapter 37, is not prohibited under the confidentiality restrictions of the Maine Banking Code, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 9-B. The original bill would 35 have defined the Treasurer of State as a "supervisory agency" which is a term normally used for agencies with bank regulatory 37 functions. This amendment does not change the substance of the bill but simply reallocates the Treasurer of State's authority to 39 get access to records to another subsection. 41
