17	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

21	'28 MRSA §456, sub-§§1 and 3, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, are amended to read:
23	<ol> <li>Licensing of seasonal agency liquor stores. The commission may issue 6-month seasonal licenses to no more than 6</li> </ol>
25	<u>4</u> special agency stores.
27	<b>3. Sunset.</b> This section is repealed on September 30, 1989, before-which-time-the 1990. The commission shall evaluate the
29	effectiveness of this section and make a written report to the
31	114th-Legislature the joint standing committee of the Legislature
	having jurisdiction over legal affairs no later than January 31, 1990.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1246, L.D. 1739

## 1 STATEMENT OF FACT 3 The amendment changes the bill by delaying the sunset provision regarding licensing of special seasonal agency liquor 5 stores until September 30, 1990, rather than repealing that 7 sunset provision. This change will allow the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs to review this licensing program 9 during the 2nd Regular Session of the 114th Legislature. 11 The amendment also changes current law to allow the commission to issue 4, rather than 6, seasonal licenses to 13 special agency stores. This change preserves the Liquor Commission's ability to authorize operation of the 4 businesses 15 currently operating under a special seasonal license, vet precludes licensing of additional special seasonal agency liquor 17 stores. 19 The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
