

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **35-A MRSA §111-A is enacted to read:**

5 **§111-A. Limitation on authority**

7 The commission shall not issue or promulgate any order or
9 rule that interferes with or impedes collective bargaining
11 negotiations under the Labor Management Relations Act, 1947,
13 Public Law 101, chapter 120.

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

15 This bill prohibits the Public Utilities Commission from
17 issuing or promulgating any order or rule that interferes with or
impedes collective bargaining under the National Labor Relations
Act.
