An Act to Establish Finance Committee Districts and Procedures for Aroostook County.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	30-A MRSA art. 3-A is enacted to read:
5	ARTICLE 3-A. AROOSTOOK COUNTY FINANCE COMMITTEE
7	<u>§739. Aroostook County finance committee</u>
9	In Aroostook County, there is established a finance
11	<u>committee to carry out the purposes of this article. As used in</u> this article, "county commissioners" means the county
13	<u>commissioners of Aroostook County.</u>
15	<b>1. Membership.</b> The finance committee shall consist of 9 members, 3 members from each commissioner district selected under
17	<u>paragraphs A and B. The county commissioners shall designate 3</u> district subdivisions within each district from each of which one
19	member of the finance committee shall be elected.
21	A. The county commissioners shall notify all municipal officers in the county to caucus by county commissioner
23	<u>district at a specified date, time and place for the purpose</u> of nominating at least one resident of each district
25	<u>subdivision of voting age as a candidate for the county</u> <u>finance committee. A county commissioner shall serve as</u>
27	<u>nonvoting moderator for the county commissioner's district</u> caucus. Nominations shall be received from the floor and
29	<u>require a majority vote of those present to be approved.</u> The names of those duly nominated shall be recorded and
31	<u>forwarded to the county commissioners to be placed on a</u> written ballot.
33	B. The county commissioners shall have written ballots
35	printed with the names of those candidates selected in each district subdivision in accordance with paragraph A. Each
37	<u>commissioner district shall require a separate ballot and each ballot shall specify each candidate's full name and</u>
39	<u>municipality. The county commissioners shall distribute the</u> <u>appropriate ballots to each municipality within a</u>
41	commissioner district. The municipal officers shall vote, as a board, for one finance committee member from each
43	commissioner district subdivision within that district from the candidates on the ballot and return the ballot to the
45	county commissioners by a date set by the county commissioners. The ballots shall be counted at a regular
47	meeting of the county commissioners. Each vote shall be weighted according to that municipality's population as a
49	proportion of the district's total population. The county commissioners shall:
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(1) Notify each municipality, in writing, of the election results; and

(2) Certify the results to the Secretary of State.

C. It is the responsibility of the county finance committee to review the budget and estimates, including the budget for municipal services in the unorganized territory prepared by the county commissioners.

- 11D. Five members of the finance committee shall serve terms<br/>of 4 years and 4 members of the finance committee shall<br/>serve terms of 2 years.13serve terms of 2 years.
- E. A vacancy occurring on the finance committee shall be filled by the committee for the balance of the unexpired term. The person appointed to fill the vacant office must be from the same municipality or unorganized territory as
  the person vacating the office.
  - F. Members shall serve without compensation.

#### 23 §739-A. Finance committee organization

25 The finance committee shall conduct its meetings in public at the county courthouse. The county commissioners shall direct 27 the county clerk to call an organizational meeting of the finance committee no later than 60 days before the end of the county's 29 fiscal year. The county commissioners shall provide the committee with necessary clerical assistance, office expenses and 31 suitable meeting space, as well as access to county files and information. The finance committee shall select its own chair, 33 vice-chair and secretary. The finance committee shall adopt its own rules or procedures and bylaws.

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#### <u>§739-B. Budget procedures</u>

 Proposed budget. The county commissioners shall submit
itemized finance estimates, as described in sections 701, 702 and 7503, in the form of a budget, to the finance committee in a
timely fashion, no later than 60 days before the end of the county's fiscal year.

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Budget review process. The finance committee shall
review the itemized estimated budget prepared by the county commissioners, together with any supplementary material prepared
by the head of each county department or provided by any independent board or institution or another governmental agency.
The finance committee shall prepare a proposed budget and may increase, decrease or alter the estimated budget provided that:

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A. The finance committee enters into its minutes an explanation for any suggested change in the estimated expenditures and revenues as initially presented by the county commissioners; and

B. In the proposed budget, the total estimated revenues, together with the amount of county tax to be levied, equals the total estimated expenditures.

3. Public hearing. The finance committee shall hold a public hearing in the county on its proposed budget before the 11 end of the county's fiscal year and before the final adoption of the budget. Notice of the hearing shall be given at least 10 13 days before the hearing in all newspapers of general circulation 15 within the county. Written notice and a copy of the proposed budget shall be sent by registered or certified mail with return receipt requested, or delivered in person, with proof of receipt 17 of the delivery, to the clerk of each municipality in the county. The municipal clerk shall notify the municipal officials 19 of the proposed budget.

4. Finality of budget. After the public hearing is completed, the finance committee shall adopt a final budget and 23 transmit that budget to the county commissioners. The county commissioners shall not further increase, decrease, alter or 25 revise the budget as adopted by the finance committee, except by unanimous vote of the county commissioners. If the adopted 27 budget is changed by the county commissioners, the finance committee may reject that change by a 2/3 vote of its 29 membership. Those actions shall be final and not subject to further action by either the county commissioners or finance 31 committee.

5. Assessment of taxes. The budget as so adopted and changed under subsection 4 is the final authorization for the assessment of county taxes. The approved final budget shall be sent to the county commissioners and the county tax authorized shall be apportioned and collected in accordance with section 706. The approved final budget for the unorganized territories 39 will be sent to the State as provided by section 7503.

6. Interim budget. Until a budget is finally approved, the county shall operate on an interim budget which shall not exceed 43 the previous year's budget.

Transfer of funds. The county commissioners may 7. transfer funds as provided in section 922. 47

49 §739-C. Budget amendments 1 The approved final budget shall govern the expenditures of the county during the fiscal year. No expenses may be incurred 3 in excess of those shown in the approved final budget, but the budget may be from time to time revised by the preparation and 5 submission of a proposed amended budget by the county commissioners to the Legislature for approval. Only after the 7 Legislature has approved an amended approved final budget, shall the amendment become effective. A report of approval of an 9 amended budget shall be transmitted to the State Auditor within 15 days of an approval of an amended budget by the Legislature.

#### <u>§739-D. Filing of county budget</u>

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A copy of the approved final budget and subsequent 15 <u>amendments shall be filed, on forms approved by the Department of</u> <u>Audit, with the State Auditor, who shall retain them for 3 years.</u> 17

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes a finance committee in Aroostook County to review the county budget. Three members of the finance committee shall be from each district, with one member from each district subdivision as designated by the county commissioners. The finance committee's budget recommendations may only be overridden by unanimous consent of the county commissioners.
