HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1269, L.D. 1765, Bill, "An Act
Establishing the Affordable Housing Partnership Act of 1989"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 21.

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to remove reference to a
study of affordable housing to be conducted by the joint standing
committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over housing and
economic development and to adjust the appropriations
accordingly. The study will be conducted by the same committee
under the oversight of the Legislative Council.
