SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1269, L.D. 1765, Bill, "An Act Establishing the Affordable Housing Partnership Act of 1989"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 19 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 11 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 11. 30-A MRSA §4852, sub-§2, ¶A-1 is enacted to read:

A-1. In addition to the uses provided in paragraph A, the following may be used to pay the administrative costs of the authority's programs:

(1) No more than 3% of the money in the fund, other than amounts derived from the dedication of the tax on real estate transfers established in Title 36, chapter 711-A;

(2) Any earnings from the fund; and

(3) Any recoveries to the fund, including, but not limited to, repayments, recaptures of principal and recaptures of interest owed.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 21 the following:

'Sec. 22. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that the responsibilities imposed upon the Maine State Housing Authority by this Act shall be carried out to the extent that appropriations are made available for those purposes.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 23, the emergency clause and the fiscal note.
