Resolve, Concerning the Dennistown Plantation School Budget.

(EMERGENCY)



1           **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the  
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after  
3 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

5           Whereas, the state fiscal year will end before the  
expiration of the 90-day period; and

7           Whereas, in order for this legislation to apply to fiscal  
9 year 1988-89, it must be enacted as emergency legislation; and

11           Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
13 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
15 safety; now, therefore, be it

17           **Dennistown Plantation; unallocated balances. Resolved:** That, for  
state fiscal years 1988-89 and 1989-90, Dennistown Plantation  
19 shall be exempt from the provisions of the Maine Revised  
Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15613, subsection 9.

21           **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the  
23 preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

29           This resolve exempts Dennistown Plantation for state fiscal  
years 1988-89 and 1989-90, from the provision of law which  
31 requires that unallocated balances in excess of 3% of the school  
budget be used to reduce allocations in computing the state  
33 subsidy.
