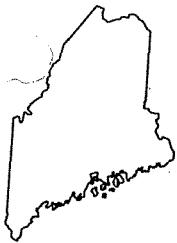

An Act Authorizing Piscataquis County to Expend and Borrow up to an Additional \$350,000 for Renovation and Expansion of Jail Facilities.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
3 as emergencies; and

5 Whereas, the county jail facility located in Dover-Foxcroft
6 is in need of immediate renovation and expansion in order to
7 ensure the safety and well-being of the inhabitants of
8 Piscataquis County; and

9 Whereas, the Legislature authorized the county
11 commissioners of Piscataquis County to borrow and expend funds
12 not to exceed \$2,400,000 for renovation and expansion of the
13 county jail facility and the voters of Piscataquis County
14 approved and authorized this borrowing and expenditure; and

15 Whereas, additional funds are required to complete the
16 project and ensure that there will be an adequate and proper jail
17 facility in Piscataquis County; and

18 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
19 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
20 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
21 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
22 safety; now, therefore,

24 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

26 **P&SL 1985, c. 105, §4-A is enacted to read:**

28 Sec. 4-A. Additional expenditure and borrowing authorized. In
29 addition to the sum authorized by section 1 to be raised and
30 expended, the county commissioners of Piscataquis County are
31 authorized to raise and expend a sum not to exceed \$350,000 for
32 renovation and expansion of the county jail facility located in
33 Dover-Foxcroft.

35 To provide the additional sum, the treasurer of Piscataquis
36 County, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow
37 funds not to exceed \$350,000 and may issue bonds and temporary
38 notes therefor, which bonds and temporary notes shall be subject
39 to sections 3 and 4 of this Act to the same extent as if they
40 were authorized by sections 3 and 4 of this Act.

42 Any grants of money or other assistance received by
43 Piscataquis County for the purposes authorized by section 1 of
44 this Act prior to the issuance of the bonds or temporary notes
45 authorized by this section shall be applied to the cost of the
46 project in lieu of the issuance of such bonds and temporary notes
47 and the authorized amount of such bonds and temporary notes shall
48 be reduced by the amount of the grants or other assistance.
