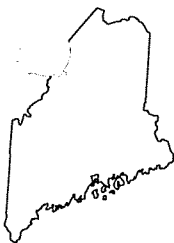

Certain Hospitals.

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **13-B MRSA §402, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 525, §13,**
5 **is amended to read:**

7 **2. Directors, officers, employees, members and**
9 **incorporators not liable. The directors, officers, employees and,**
11 **members and incorporators of the corporation shall not, as such,**
13 **be liable on its obligations.**

15 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

17 **This bill extends corporate immunity to incorporators as it**
already exists for directors, officers, employees and members of
nonprofit corporations.
