An Act to Revise the Salaries of Certain County Officers.

(EMERGENCY)



1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
3	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
5	Whereas, it has become necessary to revise the salaries of certain county officials; and
7	Whereas, it is desired to have these revisions retroactive
9	to January 1, 1989; and
11	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
13	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
15	safety; now, therefore,
