HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H.P. 1282, L.D. 1773, Bill, "An Act Regarding Governmental Ethics"

Amend the bill in section 13 in paragraph C in the 2nd line (page 7, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$50" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '\$300'

Further amend the bill in section 16 by striking out all of subsection 6-A and inserting in its place the following:

'6-A. Adopt ethics policy. By December 1, 1990, adopt an ethics policy governing the conduct of elected county officers and appointed county officials.'

Further amend the bill in section 17 by striking out all of subsection 7 and inserting in its place the following:

7. Municipal officers adopt ethics policy. The municipal officers, by December 1, 1990, shall adopt an ethics policy governing the conduct of elected municipal officers and appointed municipal officials.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains the provision in the bill that requires municipal and county officers to adopt an ethics policy, but removes the criteria that must be included in the ethics policy. In addition this amendment makes the reporting of gifts requirement for executive employees the same as the reporting requirement for Legislators. Gifts of \$300 or more must be reported.
