(EMERGENCY)
(After Deadline)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
3 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

4 Whereas, Kennebec County has certain expenses and
5 liabilities that must be met as they become due; and

7 Whereas, the sums authorized as General Fund expenditures by
8 the county in Resolve 1989, chapter 44, require some
9 modification; and

11 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1989 in
12 this resolve be immediately assessed in order to provide the
13 required revenue for the county; and

15 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
16 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
17 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
18 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
19 safety; now, therefore, be it
