HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 663, L.D. 1776, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Salaries of the Washington County Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2, sub-§1, ¶M, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c. 476, is amended to read:

Sec. 2. General Fund expenditure authorized. The personal services funds set out in Resolve 1989, chapter 36, section 2, under the Appropriation Account Number 1025, under the caption County Treasurer shall be apportioned as follows: \$9,000 shall be the salary for the County Treasurer; and \$6,000 shall be the salary for the Deputy Treasurer.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment clarifies the intent of the bill by referencing Public Law 1989, chapter 476 and Resolve 1989, chapter 36 which deal with the Washington County treasurer's salary.
