SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 666, L.D. 1779, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Medicaid Advisory Committee to the Bureau of Medical Services in the Department of Human Services"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

Medical care advisory committee. The medical care advisory committee, which is established by 42 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 431.12 and which advises the Bureau of Medical Services, Department of Human Services, shall consist of at least one member that represents providers of mental health services, to be appointed in consultation with providers of services to mentally ill persons; and at least one member that either represents families affected by mental illness, to be appointed in consultation with an alliance for the mentally ill, or represents mental health consumers, appointed in consultation with a coalition of psychiatrically labeled persons.'
