HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1288, L.D. 1781, "Resolve, to Expand the Borrowing Capacity of Knox County"

Amend the resolve by inserting after the title the following:

**'Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas,** Knox County will lose an option on property it wishes to purchase if this legislation does not become effective immediately; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**'Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and an emergency clause.
