Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted 2 as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, it is necessary that this legislation be enacted as an emergency so that funding may be appropriated to maintain the 6 existing level of vocal relay service; and 8 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 10 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 12 safety; now, therefore, 14 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 16 Appropriation.
