SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 673, L.D. 1794, Bill, "An Act to Authorize General Fund Bond Issues in the Amounts of \$35,000,000 and \$14,500,000 for Construction and Renovation of Correctional Facilities"

Amend the amendment in Part B by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Allocations from General Fund bond issue; adult correctional facilities. The proceeds of the sale of bonds shall be allocated to the Department of Corrections and expended as deemed necessary for building, repair or renovation of adult correctional facilities.'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 10 in the 5th line (page 5, line 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "1990"

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of Part C.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the date of the \$35,000,000 bond issue referendum on adult correctional facilities to November of 1989 to coincide with the other corrections bond issue referendum. The amendment also removes language from Part B, section 6, and all of Part C of the committee amendment requiring the Joint Select Committee on Corrections to study adult facilities and recommend allocations of the \$35,000,000 General Fund bond issue.
