COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 682, L.D. 1801, Bill, "An Act Concerning Operator Licenses Held by Persons 15 Years of Age"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this legislation would result in a one-time increase in revenue to the Highway Fund of approximately \$18,000 for fiscal year 1989-90. This increase in revenue is based on an anticipated 1,000 15-year-olds who would make application for drivers' licenses prior to September 29, 1989.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to add a fiscal note to the bill.
