

An Act to Adjust the Compensation for Active Retired Judges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. PL 1989, c. 501, Pt. A, under the caption "JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT", is amended to read:

Courts - Supreme, Superior, District and Administrative

Personal Services	<u>\$60,000</u>	\$60,000
		<u>\$100,000</u>

Provides funds to increase the per diem compensation for active retired justices and judges beginning December 3, 1990 1, 1989.

Sec. 22. Effective date. Sections 7, 9, 10, ~~11~~, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16 and ~~17~~ shall take effect on December 3, 1990. Sections 11, 14 and 17 shall take effect on December 1, 1989.
