16	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its
18	place the following:
20	Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §504. sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 460, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
22	B. The Director of Veterans' Services shall allow the earth
24	burial in the cemetery of any eligible veteran who requests burial in the cemetery. The director shall allow the
26	veteran the option of crypt burial if crypt space exists. All burials must be without charge.
28	Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §504, sub-§4. ¶C, as enacted by PL 1983, c.

32	C. An <u>At the dependent's request, the Director of Veterans'</u> <u>Services shall allow an</u> eligible dependent of a veteran may
34	to be buried in the cemetery if, at the date of the dependent's death, the veteran would be eligible for burial.
36	Dependents may be buried in graves the earth or placed in a crypt adjacent to the veteran without charge, provided that:
38	(1) If the veteran dies first, the dependents specify

veteran was eligible for the burial at the time of his death.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the Director of Veterans' 8 Services is required to allow burial of eligible veterans and to offer the option of crypt burial at no charge if space is 10 available. It also removes a conflicting provision regarding dependent rights which was contained in the original bill. 12
