(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, certain obligations and responsibilities will become due before the expiration of the 90-day period; and 6 8 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 10 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 12 safety; now, therefore, 14 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 16 Appropriation.
