COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1324, L.D. 1826, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Legislative Intent Governing a Position Assignment"

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

**'Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas,** the additional clerk's position created by Public Law 1989, chapter 526 should be redesignated to be within the Administrative Office of the Courts as soon as possible; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**'Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to make the redesignation of the additional clerk's position within the Administrative Office of the Court effective immediately.
