12 'Any additional costs that may result from the removal of the Animal Welfare Board from the Department of Agriculture, Food 14 and Rural Resources can be absorbed within existing resources. There would be a reduction in costs allocated to the board for 16 computers and other expenses that would offset any increase in space rental, if state-owned space is not available.'
