Resolve, to Investigate the Formation of an Interstate Insurance Compact.



(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and Whereas, the cost of insurance continues to rise; and 6 Whereas, there have been several instances when insurers threatened to pull their services out of the altogether; and 10 Whereas, municipalities have found some relief from rising 12 insurance rates by the establishment of insurance pools; and Whereas, many Maine citizens and businesses have expressed 14 concern about the continual rise in the cost of insurance; and 16 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 18 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 20 safety; now, therefore, be it 22 Sec. 1. Investigation. Resolved: That the Commission on Interstate Cooperation established by the Maine Revised Statutes, 24 Title 3, section 201, shall investigate the possibility of Maine 26 joining with other states in an interstate insurance compact for the purposes of cost reduction and formulation of compact-wide agreements related to insurance retention; and be it further 28 Sec. 2. Meetings. Resolved: That the Commission on Interstate 30 Cooperation shall meet no later than 30 days following the enactment of this resolve to develop and implement a plan for contacting other states, assessing the possibility and interest in forming an insurance compact and formulating the terms of such 34 an agreement; and be it further Sec. 3. Staff assistance. Resolved: That, if staff assistance is desired, the commission may request necessary staff assistance 38 from the Legislative Council; and be it further 40 Sec. 4. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit a 42 final report, together with any necessary implementing legislation, to the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature by December 1, 1990; and be it further 44

Sec. 5. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are

appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of

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this resolve.
