Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2 fiscal note and inserting in its place the following: 4 **'FISCAL NOTE** 6 This bill will not significantly affect budgeted revenues for the 1990-91 biennium. However, \$100 fee for biennial 8 renewals will be reduced to \$25 after February 1, 1991. If the fee is not increased by future legislation, the State Board of 10 Substance Abuse Counselors will not have sufficient revenues to cover its future estimated expenditures. Therefore, the Division 12 Licensing and Enforcement within the of Department of 14 Professional and Financial Regulation will have to cover any deficit through its assessment on other regulatory boards.' 16 STATEMENT OF FACT 18 20 This amendment removes the fee increases authorized in Committee Amendment "A" for registered, licensed and associate 22 substance abuse counselors.
