COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 701, L.D. 1839, Bill, "An Act Related to the Systems Assessment Commission"

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 22 in L.D) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. PL 1989, c. 501, Pt. A, §1, under that part designated "MENTAL HEALTH AND MENTAL RETARDATION, DEPARTMENT OF" in that part relating to "Systems Assessment Commission," by inserting at the end the following:

These funds may not lapse but must be carried forward to June 30, 1991.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that funds appropriated for the Systems Assessment Commission will carry forward to fiscal year 1990-91 to be available for the commission's activities as a result of the extension of the commission's reporting date provided by the original bill.
