COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 703, L.D. 1841, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Town of York School District"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 32 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "facilities" and inserting in its place the following: 'school facilities' and in the 6th line (page 1, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "facilities" and inserting in its place the following: 'school facilities'

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill clarifies an ambiguity in the charter of the Town of York School District. While this legislation does authorize additional borrowing for minor capital costs, which are subsidizable under General Purpose Aid for Local Schools, these additional costs could be incurred by local referendum without this bill. Therefore, the fiscal impact to school subsidy is not directly related to this bill.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note and clarifies that the Town of York School District is not responsible for minor capital costs related to facilities that are not school facilities.
