An Act to Clarify Provisions of the Hallowell Water District Charter.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1921, c. 75, §16 is enacted to read:

Sec. 16. Property tax exempt. Wherever located, real and personal property, rights and franchises of the Hallowell Water District shall be forever exempt from all forms of taxation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill adds a section to the charter of the Hallowell Water District and clarifies that all property of the district is tax exempt.
