## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Amend the Charter of the Portland Water District to Give Standish its Own Seat on the Board of Trustees.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4	Sec. 1. P&SL 1907, c. 433, §1, as repealed and replaced by P&SL 1975, c. 84, is amended to read:
6	Sec. 1. Territory. The territory and people of the Cities of Portland, South Portland and Westbrook and the Towns of Cape
8	Elizabeth, Cumberland, Falmouth, Gorham, <u>Standish</u> and Windham shall constitute the public municipal corporation named the
10	Portland Water District.
12	Sec. 2. P&SL 1907, c. 433, §18, first ¶, as repealed and replaced by P&SL 1975, c. 84, is amended to read:

16	Sec. 18. Board of trustees. The affairs of the district shall be managed by a board of trustees composed of 9 10 members,
18	4 of whom shall be elected by a plurality of voters of the City of Portland, 2 by a plurality of the voters of the City of South Portland, one by a plurality of the voters of the City of
20	Westbrook, <u>one by a plurality of the voters of the Town of</u> <u>Standish</u> , one by a plurality of the voters of the Towns of Gorham
22	and Cape Elizabeth and one by a plurality of the voters of the Towns of Cumberland, Falmouth and Windham.
