24	the use of cloth diapers in a day care facility if the facility employs a diaper laundering service. The rules must require that
26	the diaper laundering service be endorsed by a national accrediting organization and must specify the type of diaper
28	covers that must be used.

3.8	STATEMENT OF FACT
40	Currently the Department of Human Services by rule prohibits
42	the use of cloth diapers in day care facilities caring for 13 or more children. This amendment provides that cloth diapers may be used, provided that the day care facility uses a diaper
44	laundering service that has been endorsed by a national accrediting organization. The diaper laundering service
46	requirement would apply to all day care facilities, which includes facilities of 3 or more children.
