32	FISCAL NOTE
34	This bill will not significantly affect the amount of insurance premiums paid by state departments and agencies.'

38	STATEMENT OF FACT
40	Current law limits to 30 days the time for which a person
42	must be reimbursed for a rental car to replace that person's damaged vehicle. The original bill removes the 30-day limit.
44	This amendment increases the limit to 45 days.
