32	STATEMENT OF FACT
34	The purpose of the amendment is to broaden the requirement of the bill to all health care practitioners instead of just
36	chiropractors and physicians. Health care practitioners in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24, section 2502, subsection 1-A
38	include chiropractors, physical therapists, dentists, psychologists and physicians' assistants.
