COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1360, L.D. 1877, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Human Rights Act to Prohibit Educational Discrimination on the Basis of National Origin"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 by striking out all of paragraphs B and C.

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 by relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This Act may result in additional complaints filed with the Human Rights Commission. The costs associated with these additional complaints can be absorbed within existing resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes 2 paragraphs not necessarily related to discrimination in education and adds a fiscal note.
