30	payment in-the-sum of \$1,000 <u>\$3,000</u> to-the-widow-and-if-no-widow, tothechildrenand-ifnochildrentothenextofkin as
32	incidental compensation. <u>Burial expense reimbursement must be</u> paid to the person who has paid or who is responsible for paying
34	the employee's burial expenses. The incidental compensation must be paid to the employee's estate.

38	FISCAL NOTE
40	This bill will increase workers' compensation costs to the State as an employer by up to \$5,000 per death claim. The cost
42	increases will depend on the number, if any, of death claims for covered state employees. Therefore, the costs can not be
44	determined at this time.'
46	STATEMENT OF FACT
48	This amendment completely redrafts the bill and increases
50	the amount available for reimbursement of an employee's burial expenses from \$1,000 to \$4,000. This reimbursement is to be paid

to the person who paid for the burial. The amendment also
increases the amount paid as incidental compensation for a work-related death from \$1,000 to \$3,000 and provides that this
compensation is to be paid to the employee's estate.
