An Act to Increase Death Benefits under the Workers' Compensation Act.



Be it	enacted	by	the	People	of th	e State	of	Maine	as	follows:
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2 39 MRSA §59, as amended by PL 1971, c. 544, §135, is further amended to read:

### §59. Burial expenses

If the employee dies as a result of the injury, the employer shall pay, in addition to any compensation and medical benefits provided for in this Act, the reasonable expenses of burial, not to exceed \$1,000 \$5,000 and in addition thereto a payment in the sum of \$1,000 \$25,000 to the widow and if no widow, to the children and if no children to the next of kin as incidental compensation.

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### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the burial and incidental payment under the Workers' Compensation Act to \$5,000 and establishes a lump sum payment to the next of kin of \$25,000.
