COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1367, L.D. 1884, Bill, "An Act to Improve Maine Occupational Safety and Health Provisions"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill may require additional expenditures by the Bureau of Labor Standards within the Department of Labor. If Maine's occupational safety and health program qualifies for "state plan" status under federal regulations, the bureau would receive additional federal funding which would more than offset the cost of any additional requirements. Neither the amount of additional federal funds nor the resulting reduction of General Fund appropriations can be determined at this time.

In addition, the Department of Administration will be required to improve record keeping of state employee work-related injuries. These additional costs can be absorbed within the existing budgeted resources of the Department of Administration.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
