SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 720, L.D. 1895, Bill, "An Act to Expand the Borrowing Power of the Ellsworth School District"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Proposed renovation. The proposed renovation of Ellsworth High School is deemed to be a school construction project for purposes of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 609.'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in the first line (page 2, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Sec. 3." and inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 4.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

·FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes an increase in the debt limit of the Ellsworth School District to conduct a major renovation project at Ellsworth High School. Because this project would be considered and prioritized within the debt service limit of the School Finance Act of 1985, no additional General Fund appropriations will be required.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment creates a special exception to allow the
renovation project at Ellsworth High School to be considered a
school construction project subject to the debt service limit of
the School Finance Act of 1985 and replaces the fiscal note.
